COMMUNITY PROTECTION:

Widespread vaccination for COVID-19 means the virus cannot infect as many people, resulting in fewer people spreading the virus.

AT LEAST **80** PERCENT of the population needs to be vaccinated to attain community protection, according to medical experts.

NATURAL IMMUNITY:

There is not enough data available to indicate



how long someone who had COVID-19 is immune to the virus,

otherwise known as natural immunity.

Early studies indicate natural immunity may not last long, but more data is needed.

ONGOING VACCINATIONS:



At this time, it is anticipated the vaccines will be given using **only one or two shots.**

It's possible future booster shots will be needed.
